## Who is John Colgan?

It took me a couple of years teaching in AZ to build up my resume and my savings account enough to finally move to where I wanted to be: I arrived in the Portland area in May of 2014.

I was fortunate enough to get my job at Neil Armstrong MS (teaching math) for the 14/15 school year and I've been there ever since. I rented a house in Hillsboro for around a year and a half before buying my home in Cornelius. Being in Cornelius was very intentional, I really appreciate the diversity and honesty of the community. I love the walkability of our city and that I'm not dependent on a car to live my daily life—it's easy to take that for granted if you've never lived somewhere were no car means you can't do anything.

Since getting here: I've served two years on the Cornelius Budget Committee, six years on City Council (so far), I've volunteered as a tutor in our library, I've finished a Masters Degree in Education, gotten one divorce (always learn from your mistakes), gotten married again, and started my own tiny little business making nick-nacks out of wood. I enjoy fishing, camping, exploring, cooking, video games, astronomy, watching tv and movies, and I'm constantly reading books.
